

LSBU School Awards for International Students 2017/18

Terms and Conditions

- 1. To be eligible for a London South Bank University (LSBU) School Award for International Students, the student must:
 - Hold a valid and current offer of a place for a full time taught postgraduate degree programme beginning in September 2017 by the Award deadline.
 - Have achieved the Scholarship's academic pre-requisites in the qualification being considered for entry, according to the Appendix below.
 - Be classified as an Overseas Student for fee paying purposes. The programme must be a minimum of one year in duration and taught on campus at LSBU.
 - Be a self-funding student who is not in receipt of any other official sponsorship.
- 2. To be considered for this Award, students will need to have submitted an application for a postgraduate taught programme by the deadline of 30 June 2017 providing all required documents.
- 3. All decisions are made by the Scholarship Panel and are final.
- 4. The School Awards for International Students will be given in the form of a fee reduction at enrolment, provided that the student is able to do the following:
 - Produce the required documents to confirm academic/English language qualifications.
 - Produce their passport to confirm nationality status and hold the required valid visa for study.
- 5. The School Awards for International Students awarded to eligible students enrolling onto a postgraduate degree programme commencing in September 2017 will be for the first academic year of the programme and for taught programmes only.
- 6. Should a School Award for a particular School(s) not be awarded in September 2017, the Award(s) will be available for the January 2018 intake should there be courses available. Should there be any remaining School Awards following the September intake, applicants who have submitted an application for courses commencing in January 2018 by 27th October 2017 will be considered.

- 7. If at any stage in the process of assessing and awarding an Award, documents are found not to be genuine, the Award will be immediately withdrawn. The University will not be held liable for this action.
- 8. The programme of study must be at least one year in duration and the tuition fee must be a minimum of £7,500.
- 9. Students in bad financial standing will not be eligible to claim the Award.
- 10. Students in receipt of any other LSBU scholarship or overseas institution discount will not be eligible for the School Awards for International Students.
- 11. The School Awards for International Students are not available to continuing students who are already enrolled at LSBU.
- 12. Each School Award recipient will act as an international brand ambassador for their School and LSBU, and must be willing to participate in marketing activities, both during the course and as an alumni following graduation.
- 13. London South Bank University reserves the right to amend these terms and conditions at any time.
