There is one scholarship worth £4,000 towards the fees for full time or part time UK or EU students on the following programmes:

- MSc Building Surveying
- MSc Construction Project Management
- MSc Quantity Surveying.

The Scholarship will be awarded primarily on academic merit, evidence of applicants' commitment to their future career and their previous practical or academic achievement. Selection will be made by the scholarship panel whose decision will be final. No appeals will be received.

- You must provide evidence of your academic results and degree classification, and proof of your offer of a place on your course (see final page for examples).
- Applications should be legible: e.g. typed or word-processed, signed and dated.
- Applications received after the closing date will not be considered.
- Scholarship applications will only be accepted from those who have accepted an offer (conditional or unconditional) of a place on MSc Building Surveying, MSc Construction Project Management or MSc Quantity Surveying.

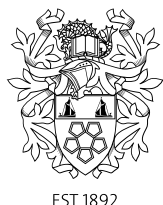

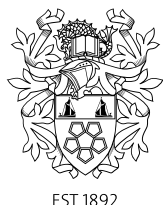

Notes for Applicants:

1. Applicants must hold an unconditional or a conditional offer for MSc Building Surveying, MSc Construction Project Management or MSc Quantity Surveying in 2018/19 on or before the given deadline.
2. Only fully completed applications including requested documents will be considered by the panel. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
3. Scholarship applications must be received at LSBU by the deadlines given.
4. Scholarships will be awarded by a scholarship panel on evidence of academic merit, commitment to career goals and previous practical or academic achievement.
5. All decisions by the scholarship panel are final. Scholarships will be given in the form of a fees reduction at enrolment, provided that the recipient produces the official certificate.
6. We are unable to inform unsuccessful applicants. If feedback has not been received within 4 weeks of the deadline it can be assumed that the application has been unsuccessful.
7. Scholarships awarded for the academic period 2018/19 cannot be deferred to an alternative academic year.
8. If at any stage in the process of assessing and awarding a scholarship, documents are found not to be genuine the application will be immediately withdrawn.
9. Successful applicants for the programme are not eligible in the same academic year for any other LSBU scholarship or any discount on tuition fees.
10. Scholarship holders will be required to assist in marketing activities for LSBU. Activities may include student testimonials and photos for usage on the website, posters, mailshots and attendance at recruitment events.
