

Numeracy Testing Application Process

Terms and Conditions

- Candidates must present a valid passport to confirm their identity as part of the registration process on the day of their test.
- Tests will begin half an hour after the allotted arrival time on the invitation; candidates are advised to arrive promptly to allow sufficient time to complete their registration.
- Candidates will not be allowed into the testing centre once the tests have begun.
- The use of calculators is not allowed and all mobile phones should be switched off and left in a bag under the desk.
- Candidates are allotted up to 30 minutes to complete the numeracy test. Extra time will be allocated to those who have support needs and require reasonable adjustments.
- Once a candidate has completed the test to their own satisfaction they must ensure that they submit the test.
- Candidates should leave the room quietly once they have completed and submitted their test.
- The test will be marked as either pass or fail and will not be graded.
- Test results are final and cannot be appealed.
- Candidates must achieve a pass to progress to the next stage of the application process.
