Living just minutes away from the world-famous sights of the city, you will be able to access London's numerous museums, art galleries, restaurants and shops.





Glossary of terms

PROGRAMME	DESCRIPTION	DURATION
Higher National Certificate (HNC) / Higher National Diploma (HND)	A vocational higher education qualification, equivalent to the first part of a degree. These can be used to progress onto a Top-up or advanced entry to an Honours degree.	1 or 2 years
Top-up to BA (Hons)/ BSc (Hons)	Top up to the final year of a bachelor's honours degree by building on existing qualifications or experience.	1 or 1.5 years
Honours Degree	An undergraduate course leading to a UK bachelor's qualification such as BA (Hons); BSc (Hons); BEng (Hons); LLB (Hons).	3 or 4 years
MEng (Hons)	An undergraduate integrated Master's course focused on engineering, combining a bachelor degree and master degree.	4 or 5 years

Students who do not meet the University's academic entry criteria may consider one of the academic foundation programmes.

Extended Degree Programme	A course for applicants who do not satisfy the requirements for entry to Year 1 of a degree course. It prepares you for entry to our degree-level course. Available in the School of Engineering, the School of Applied Sciences and the School of The Built Environment and Architecture.	4 or 5 years (inclusive of full degree)
Undergraduate Foundation Programme	A course to prepare those who have completed senior secondary education, for progression to an undergraduate degree programme.	1 year

POSTGRADUATE

PROGRAMME	DESCRIPTION	DURATION
Masters Degree	A postgraduate taught programme which includes a significant piece of independent work and leads to a qualification such as: MA; MSc; MBA; LLM.	Typically 1 year
Postgraduate Diploma	A taught programme which leads to a postgraduate diploma (PgDip). A PgDip can be used to progress to a full masters degree.	Typically 1 year
Research Masters	A research-orientated postgraduate degree programme leading to the MRes qualification.	Typically 1 year
Research Degree	A postgraduate research programme that leads to the award of: MPhil; PhD.	Typically MPhil 2 years PhD 3 years

STUDYING IN THE UK

University programmes in the UK have approximately 15 hours of contact time with lecturers and academics per week, but will vary depending on your course and the timetable each semester. Classes can take the form of lectures, seminars and practical lab or workshop sessions. You are assessed on your course through a number of means including, exams, essays, coursework, presentations, research papers, project work and a dissertation. ■



Essential information

A qualification from LSBU is an investment in your future. An undergraduate, postgraduate or professional qualification from LSBU will give you an internationally recognised qualification that will provide a solid career foundation and excellent employment prospects.

TUITION FEES
