

LSBU International Merit Scholarships 2020/21

Terms and Conditions

- To be eligible for a London South Bank University (LSBU) International Merit Scholarship the student must:
 - Hold a valid and current offer of a place for a full time taught undergraduate degree or taught postgraduate degree programme beginning in September 2020 or January 2021.
 - Have achieved the scholarship's academic pre-requisites in the qualification being considered for entry, according to the Appendix below.
 - Be classified as an Overseas student at enrolment stage. The programme must be a minimum of one year in duration and taught by LSBU.
 - Be a self-funding student who is not in receipt of any other official sponsorship.
 - Pay the required tuition fee deposit by the specified deadline, if applicable.
- 2. All decisions are made by the scholarship panel and are final.
- 3. International Merit Scholarships will be given in the form of a fee reduction at enrolment, provided that the student is able to do the following:
 - Pay the first instalment of tuition fees.
 - Produce the required documents to confirm academic/English language qualifications.
 - Produce their passport to confirm nationality status and hold the required right to study.
- 4. International Merit Scholarships awarded to eligible students enrolling onto an undergraduate degree programme commencing in September 2020 or January 2021 will be awarded for each year of the programme, where the student is undertaking full-time study at LSBU.

- 5. International Merit Scholarships awarded to eligible students enrolling onto a postgraduate taught degree programme commencing in September 2020 or January 2021 will be awarded for each year of the programme, where the student is undertaking full-time study at LSBU and the taught year meets/ exceeds the minimum cost in point 7.
- 6. If at any stage in the process of assessing and awarding a scholarship, documents are found not to be genuine, the scholarship will be immediately withdrawn. The university will not be held liable for this action.
- 7. The programme of study must be at least one year in duration and the tuition fee must be a minimum of £7,500 per year.
- 8. Students in bad financial standing will not be eligible to claim the scholarship.
- Students in receipt of any other LSBU scholarship or overseas institution discount will not be eligible for the International Merit Scholarship.
 For students in receipt of an International Merit Scholarship, the 5% Early Payment Discount will still apply.
- 10. The scholarship is not transferrable against any tuition fee deposit, if applicable.
- International Merit Scholarships are not available to continuing students who are already enrolled at LSBU.
- 12. London South Bank University reserves the right to amend these terms and conditions at any time.
