CAGED-FREE PURCHASING POLICY

Purpose

This purchasing policy defines the way in which we operate and manage the purchasing of whole & shell eggs.

Scope

The policy is an information tool for our clients and operators, within London South Bank University practices and approach to egg purchasing.

Responsibilities

The Elior UK Purchasing Department's principal commitment is to ensure our suppliers deliver products and services to our business via a safe supply chain, ensuring compliance to legislative food and safety regulations. We work alongside the Elior UK Safety & Wellbeing Team to maintain the highest standards. These are monitored by regular audits of supplier premises and practices.

The Elior team will only purchase eggs that have not been sourced from hens in barren battery cages. All eggs used will be purchased from our nominated suppliers and will be fully Red Lion certified and free range.

Governance

The policy is reviewed at least annually by the unit senior management team and will be revised in accordance to any changes in legislation. We will be advised on these changes by Elior UK Purchasing department and Compassion in World Farming.
