Student Residences Snow and Ice Clearance Arrangements

The winter months can present specific problems due to snow and ice. In the event of snow and heavy ice the following actions will take place:

- Each residence has a supply of salt and equipment to assist the removal of ice and snow.
- The weather forecast will be monitored by residence staff and when heavy ice or snow is predicted for the following day, staff will make arrangements to lay down grit.
- Upon the build-up of snow, main entrances and steps to buildings/blocks will be cleared. Main walkways within courtyards will be gritted.
- Car parks will not be gritted.
- The clearance and gritting of public footpaths is the responsibility of the local council. Further information will be available on the Southwark Council's web site below:

- Staff and students should be encouraged to walk and not run and to wear footwear with a non-slip sole.
- Allow more time to get to the chosen destination.
