



Notice: Changes to 2020/21 Teaching In Response to Covid-19

In response to government guidance and social distancing measures in effect due to Covid-19, the university is moving to a model of blended learning for the 2020/21 academic year. This means that teaching and learning on your course will consist of both online and on-campus activity. Whilst we hope to deliver as much activity on-campus as possible, social distancing measures will inform how much teaching we can deliver face-to-face. For the 2020/21 academic year, it is expected that the majority of your course will be delivered online.

What this means for your course

Your learning outcomes will stay the same but there might be changes to its delivery, assessment and teaching structure. Your final award will have the same value as before. We will send you more information on any significant course changes, as soon as we can.
