With the closure of London Road in August 2019, the School of Arts and Creative Industries (ACI) will be returning to the historic Borough Road building, bringing together under one roof Elephant Studios, the Edric Theatre, Borough Road Gallery and the ACI Deanery.

For the 2019/20 and 2020/21 academic years, the School has invested £3.5 million to move Elephant Studios into Borough Road, ensuring that students will still have access to industry standard facilities they expect at London South Bank University (LSBU). This includes moving the range of multidisciplinary facilities designed to equip you with the necessary practical skills and experience for your future creative career, such as the Newsroom (which will have an increased capacity), Photography Studio and Film Studio to name but a few. What does this mean for ACI students in 2019/20 and 2020/21?

Where possible we have replicated the industry standard facilities from Elephant Studios (London Road) into Elephant Studios 2 in Borough Road. The only exceptions are the Game Design Studios, Cinema and Mac Lab which will be based in:

- Game Design Studio – K2
- Mac Lab – K2
- Cinema Room – Towerblock (T214)
