This, I'd say, represents nature and my appreciation for beauty and just scenery in general... I love being out in nature so much.



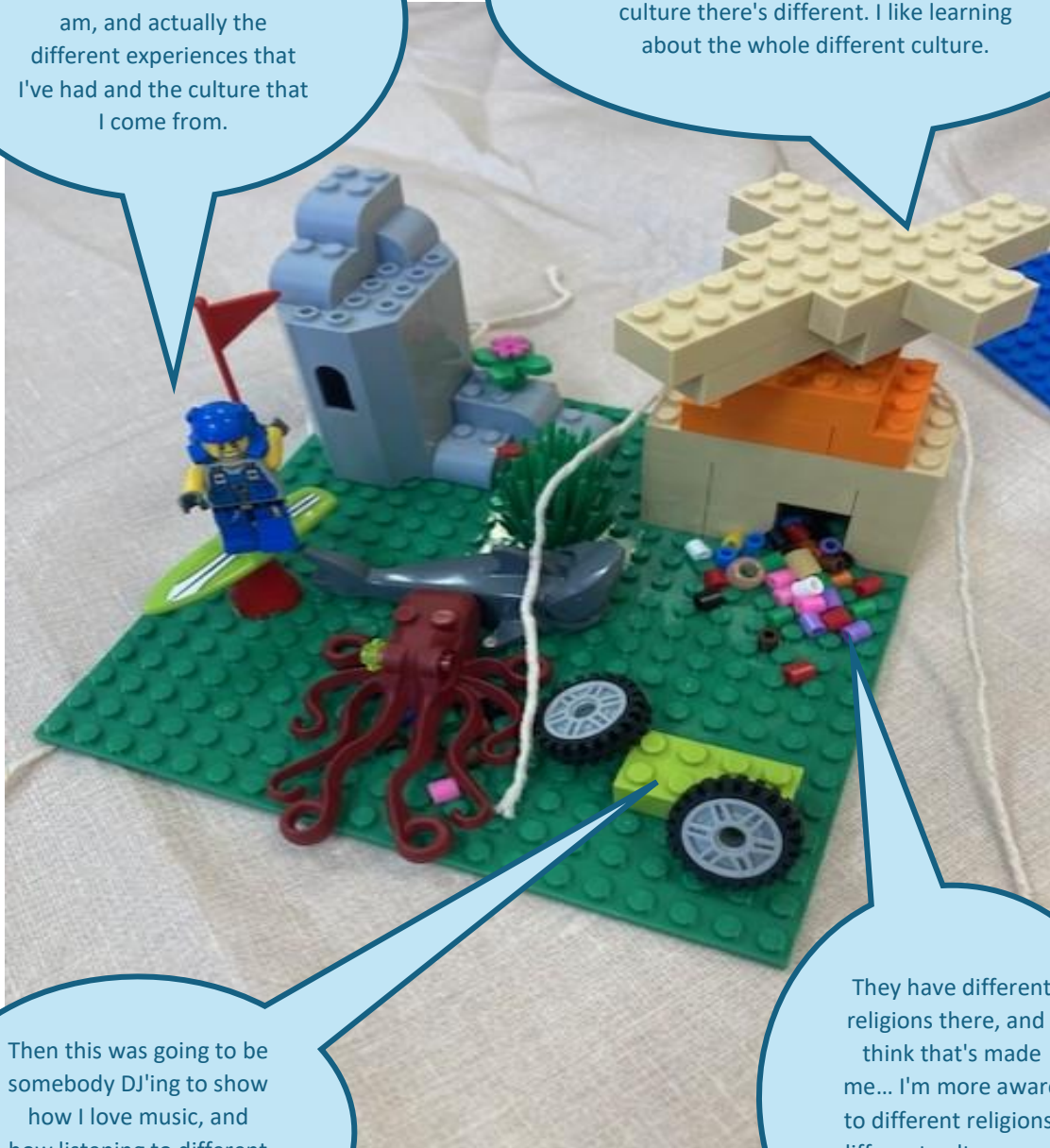
