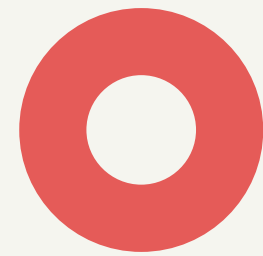
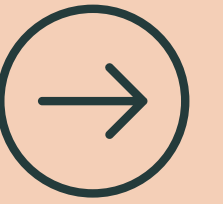

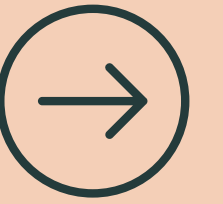
Gender Equality in Education in Vietnam

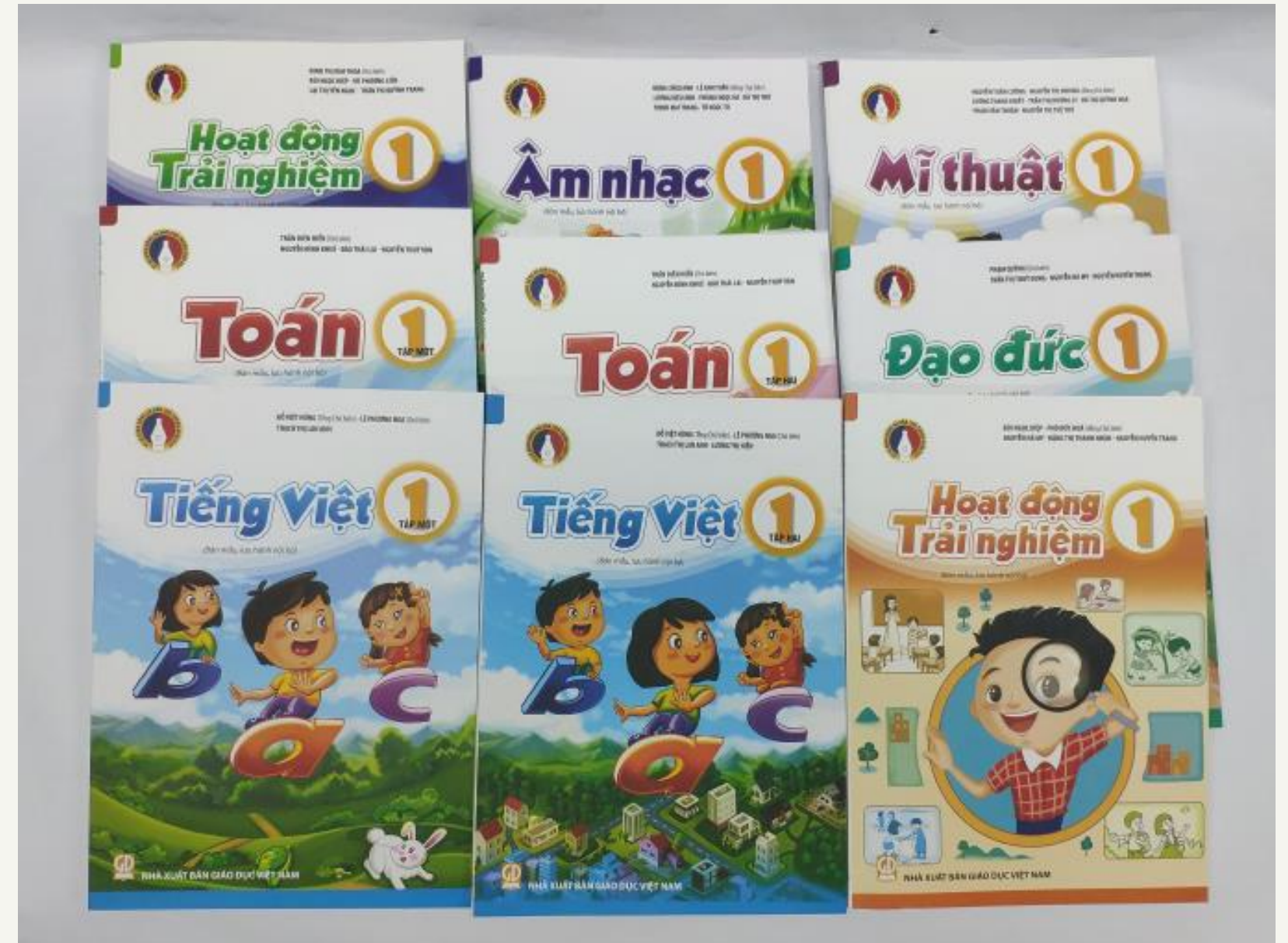

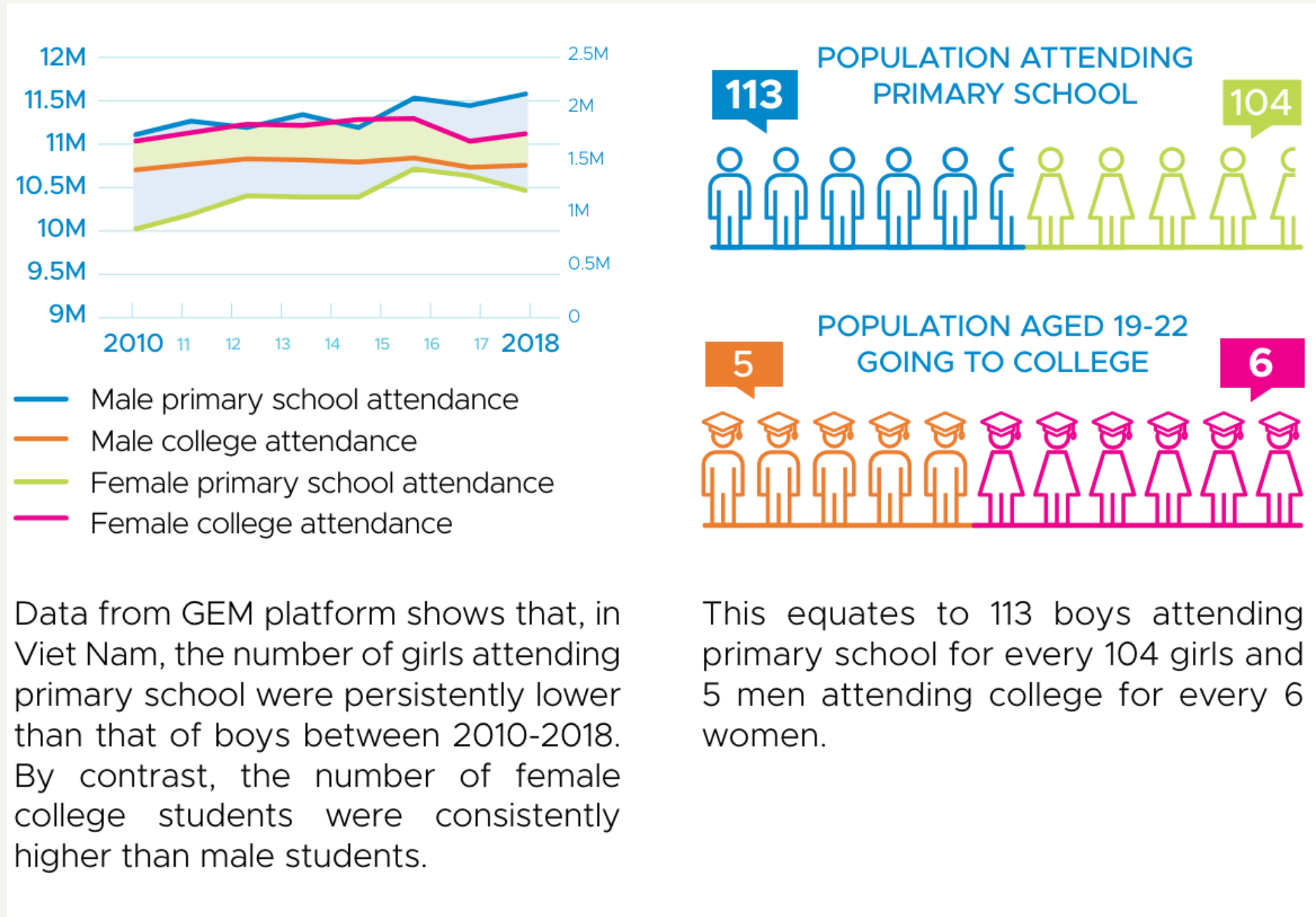

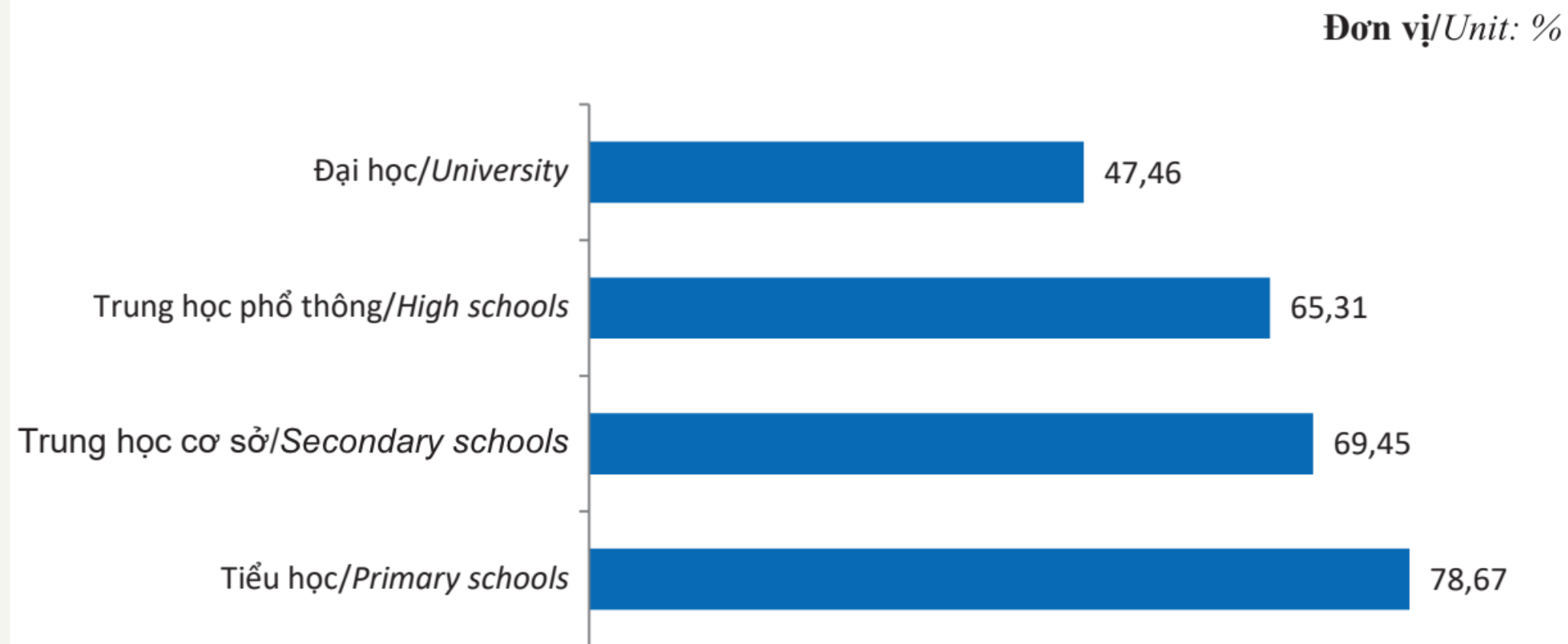


BIRTH RATE BY GENDER

school year 2020-2021



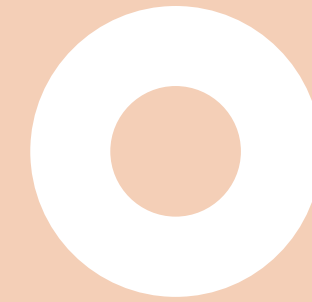

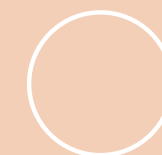
