Occupational Health Checks

All students commencing a healthcare course in the Institute of Health and Social Care are required to undergo an Occupational Health Check. This process is compulsory and not optional.

In the Institute of Health and Social Care we work closely with our specialist provider OH Works. They have a team of staff that are dedicated and work exclusively with our students to support them with their OH requirements. All new students are required to attend an Occupational Health appointment to ensure that they have the necessary health clearances prior to attending placement. All students who have been offered a place will be issued with details of the online pre-course health screening questionnaire that must be completed within 4 weeks of receipt. You will also receive a guide and information containing frequently asked questions.

Through the information provided in the pre-course health screening questionnaire it may be necessary for you to attend an appointment prior to the start of the course.

It is important to note that failure to complete the pre-course health screening questionnaire and attend appointments that have been made may result in the withdrawal of the conditional or unconditional offer that has previously been made.

When completing the pre-screening questionnaire all applicants have duty of care when providing information that is honest and accurate.
