

LSBU International Scholarships 2021/22

Terms and Conditions

- To be eligible for a London South Bank University (LSBU) International Scholarship the student must:
 - Hold a valid and current offer of a place for a full-time taught undergraduate degree or postgraduate taught or research degree programme beginning in the academic year 2021/22.
 - Be classified as an Overseas Student for fee paying purposes. The programme must be a minimum of one year in duration and delivered by LSBU.
 - Be a self-funding student who is not in receipt of any other official sponsorship.
 - Pay the required tuition fee deposit by the specified deadline.
- All decisions are made by the scholarship panel and are final.
- Scholarships will be given in the form of a fee reduction at enrolment, provided that the student is able to do the following:
 - Pay the first instalment of tuition fees.
 - Produce the required documents to confirm academic/English language qualifications.
 - Produce their passport to confirm nationality status and hold the required right to study.
- £1,500 scholarships awarded to students enrolling onto an undergraduate degree commencing in the academic year 2021/22 will be available for each subsequent taught full year of the programme (excluding the work placement year for students taking the sandwich degree option and the short second year for students studying a top-up degree programme) providing that the student progresses successfully.
- Scholarships will not be available to students repeating the whole, or any part, of the academic year.
- The scholarship, awarded to eligible students enrolling onto a postgraduate doctoral degree programme, is for the first academic year of the programme only.
- If at any stage in the process of assessing and awarding a scholarship, documents are found not to be genuine, the scholarship will be immediately withdrawn. The university will not be held liable for this action.
- The programme of study must be at least one year in duration.
- Tuition fees charged for undergraduate and taught postgraduate programmes must be £7,500 or more.
- The Scholarship is awarded to eligible MRes, MPhil and PhD students irrespective of tuition fee amount being charged.
- Students in bad financial standing will not be eligible to claim the scholarship.
- Students in receipt of any other LSBU scholarship or overseas institution discount will not be eligible for the International Scholarship.
- Students in receipt of an International Scholarship may also qualify for the 5% Early Payment Discount if they pay their overseas tuition fees in full by the specified deadline prior to enrolment.
- The scholarship is not transferable against the tuition fee deposit.
- If, as the result of a withdrawal or interruption from studies, fees are reduced, the scholarship will be immediately withdrawn unless the student interrupts through pregnancy/maternity/paternity.
- London South Bank University reserves the right to amend these terms and conditions.
